HJR 6: Oppose

Dear Committee:

The Oregon Progressive Party (OPP) opposes this bill, which purports to redistrict the Oregon Senate into 36 single-member districts, one for each county.

This bill is obviously unconstitutional, as it would directly violate the one-person one-vote rule that applies to state legislatures. This was decided by the United States Supreme Court in <u>Reynolds v. Sims</u> in 1964, which struck down the Alabama statute that allocated one state senator per county--exactly the same as HJR 6.

One wonders why the Oregon Legislature is spending time on this bill. Perhaps this is just a vehicle for a later gut-and-stuff.
