Position on Bill at 2021 Session of Oregon Legislature:

HB 2928, HB 2936, HB 2481, HB 3059: Support

Dear Committee:

The Oregon Progressive Party (OPP) supports these bills:

HB 2928: Regulates use of chemical incapacitants, kinetic impact projectiles and sound devices by law enforcement agencies.

HB 2481: Prohibits law enforcement agencies from receiving certain military surplus equipment from federal government.

HB 3059: Repeals statute authorizing law enforcement officers to command dispersal of unlawful assemblies and arrest participants who do not disperse.

HB 2932: Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to establish statewide database of reports of use of physical force by peace officers and corrections officers.

HB 3145: Directs Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to establish publicly available database of certain information about misconduct and discipline of public safety employees established by department.

HB 3164: Modifies crime of interfering with a peace officer or parole and probation officer.
